- Tuesday July 1st: Canada Day - SESSION CANCELLED
- The week of July 28th: Season ends


Parents

Parking at Somerton Park




- Use the parking lot adjacent to the field




Parking at Roland Michener




Parking at Klondike Park




- There is a small parking lot at the school on Halton Terrace


